## **Vision**

The Singing Men of Central Wisconsin is a non-denominational sacred men's chorus. We hope to recruit 25-35 men to sing at various Christian functions and churches in Central Wisconsin, including Madison, Portage, Baraboo, Reedsburg, Sauk Prairie and Spring Green.

We also hope to be asked to sing the national anthem at various sports events in the Central Wisconsin area and to plan for 1 or two major concerts each year, and perhaps join with The Singing Men of Oak Brook at one of their annual concerts either at Christmas time or in the Spring.

Singing Men music publications from Hope Publishing Company in Wheaton, Illinois and other music as we can borrow it from The Singing Men of Oak Brook. At this time (November 2008), we have not recruited a director or a regular pianist, but will be engaged in doing that in the next few months.

We plan to practice each week, at this date, Wednesday nights at 7:45 at Sauk Prairie Evangelical Free Church in Prairie du Sac, Wisconsin, where we will have the use of a fairly new Grand Piano. As we get our director and pianist(s) lined up, we will send updates to you.
